

TimberGlow Wood Burning Sauna Heater Installation Instructions

(Chimney Out The Top)



Requirements:

2 People (recommended)

Cordless Drill
Phillips & Robertson Drill Bits
2" hole Saw
Jig Saw
Carpenters Level

Tape Measure Step Ladder 11mm Socket 13mm Socket

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(Chimney out the top)

Before Starting the assembly of your TimberGlow wood heater, remove the protective film from the heater shield and floor plate.



Place the heat shield on the floor in the sauna where the stove will be.



Place the wall heat shield so the bottom is around 2" (51mm) from the floor of the sauna.



Ensure the heat shield is level and attach to the wall with $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " (38mm) screws.





Before Starting the assembly of your TimberGlow wood heater, remove the protective film from the heater shield and floor plate.



Place the heat shield on the floor in the sauna where the stove will be.



Bring the heater in and place it on top of the floor shield.

It should be 10" from the heat shield to the center of the hole on the stove.



At the top of the sauna, measure 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " (30cm) and make a mark.

Measure 4" (10cm) in all directions from the center point.





Use the chimney stack to trace out a circle around the marks made in the previous step.



Cut out the circle with a jig saw.



Place the shorter chimney connector piece onto the flange off the heater.



Place the longer chimney connector piece onto the short piece.





Slide the bottom chimney stack through the roof hole and into the connector pipe.



On the top of the sauna, slide the rubber membrane over the chimney stack.

Mark the outline of the membrane.



Lift the membrane out of the way and apply the included roof sealant on the inside of the outline.



Slide the membrane back down and secure using the included self-sealing roofing screws every 1-2" (25mm to (51mm)





Place the hose clamp over the membrane and tighten the screw.



Connect the 2nd insulated chimney piece onto the first.



Attach the support strap around the chimney pipes and tighten up.



Slide the chimney cap into the top stack and fold over the tab to secure it in place.





Install the 2 halves of the chimney hole shield around the chimney on the inside to cover the hole and secure with $6 - 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " (38mm) screws.



Place the rocks in the heater until they are 2" (51mm) above the top of the heater.

(It is recommended to wash the stones before placing in the heater to remove any dirt & debris)
